

SIP Summary from Student Services

The Student Services department supports rigorous academic performance and safe school goals. The academic objectives for 2011-12 are that students will improve their academic performance by achieving at least C's for the year and pass all quarterly assessments. Safe school goals are a 10% reduction in disciplinary referrals related to disrespect for others (both peers and adults). Some examples of strategies are coordinating school-wide initiatives such as the RESPECT program, classroom instruction, on-going monitoring of academic performance and student behaviors, parent meetings, Core+ group instruction, consultation with parents and staff, and individual and group counseling. Student Services goals mirror goals established by the grade level teams so that all staff are working toward student success.
