

Math Team Improvement Plan Summary based on needs assessment:

- Objective #1: By June 2012, the percentage of Special Education students scoring advanced or proficient on the MSA will be at least 85.7% in all grade levels.
- Objective #2: By June 2012, the percentage of students receiving free and reduced meals scoring advanced or proficient on the MSA will be at least 85.7% in all grade levels.
- Objective #3: By June 2012, the percentage of students passing quarterly assessments with 70% or better in on-grade-level classes will be 100%.
- Objective #4: By June 2012, the percentage of students passing quarterly assessments with 75% or better in honors-level classes will be 100%.
- Objective #5: By June 2012, the percentage of students passing quarterly assessments with 80% or better in Gifted & Talented classes will be 100%.
- There are many strategies that the math team will use to meet these goals. A *sampling* of some strategies are:
 - Core+ math intervention groups
 - Homeroom support/intervention by math teachers
 - Firstinmath.com online program and incentives
 - Use of lunch support and Saturday academy for make-up and remediation.
