

Summary of the 6th Grade Team Improvement Plan 2011-12

The 6th grade team will focus on three major areas during the 2011-12 school year. The first goal is to maintain the high attendance rates that FQMS has exhibited in the past. By the end of the 2011-12 school year, the 6th grade will maintain an attendance rate of at least 97% in each quarter. The second area to address is lateness to school. The team will run multiple incentive programs as well as focus on making families aware of the importance of being to school on time. By the end of the 2010-11 school year, the 6th grade will decrease the incidences of lateness (excused and unexcused) by 10% over 2010-11 school year; and less than 2% of the 6th grade, will have 5 or more incidences of lateness per quarter. Furthermore, the 6th grade team will focus on reducing the overall number of office referrals. By the end of the 2011-12 school year, the 6th grade will not exceed the number of overall office referrals incurred in the previous school year. No more than 2% of the 6th grade will have 2 or more referrals in any quarter. Additionally, by the end of the 2011-12 school year, less than 1.5% of 6th grade students will receive referrals for harassment/bullying and less than 2% will be suspended for inappropriate behaviors. Finally, the 6th grade team aims to increase the awareness of developmental assets by 2% this school year. The 6th grade team will work closely with the Guidance department to plan activities that will indicate an increase of at least 2 of 40 developmental assets by the end of the school year.
