Dear Parents/Guardians:

Below is a listing of all of the activities being offered after school at Folly Quarter Middle School this spring. If your child is interested in participating, please complete the attached Permission Slip and Intramural Transportation Form. To prepare our students for high school requirements, any student who wishes to participate must have a GPA of at least 2.0 with no D's or E's to participate in an activity, with the exception of Homework Club. Activity sponsors will verify that students are eligible to participate in their program. All students participating in these programs need to arrange their own transportation. If a student is picked up from a session late more than 3 times, they will not be allowed to continue participating. There is a fee of \$35 for each activity (separate check for each activity). Any student deciding to quit a club will not get a refund after the first week. Checks for these fees should be made payable to FQMS PTA and returned to the front office to the attention of Clara Peluso.

Scholarships are available for those who need assistance and can apply by contacting the Folly Quarter Administration. Completed forms and money are due in the front office by March 12, 2012. Classes fill up quickly and each class is limited in size.

Unless otherwise noted, all spring intramurals will begin the week of March 19 and run through to the week of June 1, 2012, from 2:30 p.m. until 3:30 p.m.

Important Note: Classes are limited in size and the classes will fill quickly. Make sure you get the forms in as soon as possible. Checks will be returned if the class fills up or if the class needs to be canceled due to not enough students participating. Return forms and money to the Front Office.

Falcon Friends pairs students with disabilities with their non-disabled schoolmates and teaches students through interactive activities and service learning the value of diversity, acceptance, and helping others. A \$10 materials fee will be collected on the first day of class with check made out to FQMS. Limited to 12 students.

Students may only participate if they have turned in a permission slip, money, and transportation form signed by a parent/guardian. Any change in the schedule will be announced in advance. Cancellations will be made known through morning announcements. Due to this possibility, please make sure your child knows what plans he/she should follow to go home at the end of the day before a cancellation occurs. If your child is unable to attend one of their program's sessions, please provide a note to the program sponsor indicating that they will not be in attendance that day. Students should dress appropriately for their program. All students are expected to follow school policies and procedures at all times. Should the club not meet the minimum number of participants, your fee will be returned to your child.
