Dear Parents/Guardians,

All HCPSS middle schools are participating in the assessment initiative, Measures of Academic Progress® (MAP®). The MAP assessments are unlike any other assessments that HCPSS administers in that they are designed to provide information on individual instructional skill levels and growth over time for each student. This information is invaluable as classroom teachers design lessons to meets students' instructional needs.

This week, September 26^{th} - 30^{th} , we are administering the math portion of the assessment to all 6^{th} grade students and all 7^{th} and 8^{th} grade students taking Common Core Math. The reading portion of MAP will be administered to all students the week of October 10^{th} - 16^{th} .

MAP assessments in reading and mathematics are taken on the computer and are programmed to adapt to your child's current instructional level. The test is untimed, so there are no defined time constraints, however, generally it takes approximately 50 minutes for students to complete the test. Your child's MAP results will not be a factor in his/her grades.

Students will receive MAP "home reports" with their first quarter report cards as well as a Student Progress Report Quick Reference that provides explanations and notes for parents.
