Immunization Requirements

7th Grade Parents: Effective on September 5, the first day of school, the following immunizations are required by the state of Maryland for all students entering grade 7:

1 dose of Tdap vaccine and 1 does of Meningococcal (MCV4). Many students have already received these immunizations, but the health room may not have the updated immunization record. Please check your child's doctor and send an updated copy of your child's immunization record to the health room.

School Meals
