Devices/Cell Phones/Smart Watches - Oh My!

Per Policy 8080 Updates for Middle School (Personal Devices - Cell Phones/Smart Watches etc):

- 1. Students will not use personal technology devices during non-instructional time, to include but not limited to transition between classes, lunch, recess, or in bathrooms.
- 2. A school administrator may, on occasion, authorize the use of personal technology devices for special events and/or for positive behavioral supports and interventions.

This means: Off and away unless a teacher or administrator gives permission to use for something specific.

HCPSS Chromebooks



-HCPSS is now a 1 to 1 county. This means every student is assigned a HCPSS Chromebook that they need to bring to and from school every day.

-There are no longer computer carts at FQMS for students to use during lessons.

-Students should pick up a HCPSS Chromebook during orientation if they do not have one already assigned to them.

-FQMS staff can only provide technology support for HCPSS Chromebooks. Technology support will not be provided for personal computers.
