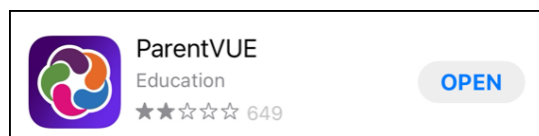

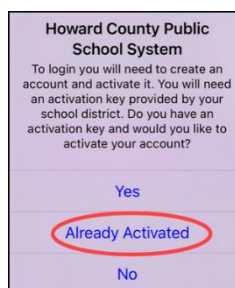
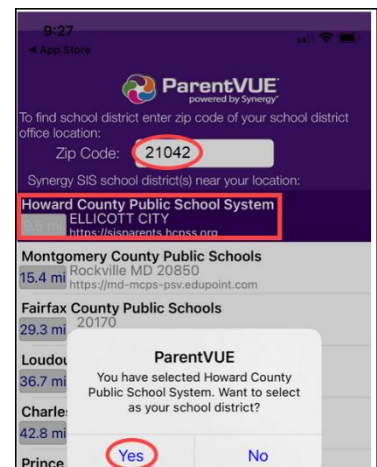
Parents may use the ParentVUE mobile app to record the proper pronunciation of a child's name. This recording will be available to teachers, school administrators, and school support staff.

Download the ParentVUE App

1. In the App Store on your mobile device, search for the **Synergy ParentVUE** mobile app. The app can be downloaded to any iOS (Apple) or Android device.
2. Once the app downloads, click **Open**.



3. You will see a welcome message and instructions to swipe left to locate your school district.
4. Enter your **Zip Code** in the field provided. You will see a list of local school districts.
5. Select **Howard County Public School System**.
6. Click **Yes** to confirm your selection.
7. In the next screen, you will be asked about activating your account with an activation code. All accounts are already activated and no activation code is necessary. Select **Already Activated**.
8. Enter your username (email address) and password and click **Login**.

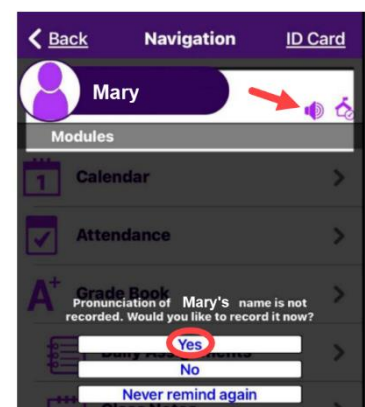


Record Pronunciation

1. After you login to HCPSS Connect, tap on the name of the child.
2. If the name has not yet been recorded, you will be asked if you want to record it now. Select **Yes**.

📧 **NOTE:** You can select **No** if you do not want to record now or **Never remind again** if you don't want to be prompted each time you login.

📧 **NOTE:** If you have recorded your child's name and want to record it again, just click on the speaker icon at any time. Also, if you click Never remind again, you can opt to record a name at any time by clicking on the speaker icon.



3. On the Record screen, tap the red record button and record the pronunciation of the child's name.
4. When you are done, you may review, delete, or re-record the pronunciation. Click **Close** to save the recording and leave the page.

The pronunciation of your child's name will now be available to teachers, school administrators, and school support staff.
